

Kids of the Kingdom

Role of the Cell Leader

- Come downstairs immediately after church to the worship center room
- replace the greeters and storytellers
- help the children during the time of singing
- accompany the children through the 4 activities (table, reading room, prayer room, craft room)
- Assist in the craft and reading rooms and at the activity table

**Prayer room

- will lead this activity

*light the candle and say...

“We light the Christ candle to remind us that Christ is here with us.”

- read the prayer listed for the day (next page)
- discuss the prayer and use as prompt for the day
- ask each child for their prayer requests
- fill out each request on the child’s journal sheet
- Pray for all of their concerns as well as what they have learned that day
- Snuff out the candle
- Stay in the room until dismissed
- Approximately 8 minutes for this activity

Role of a Greeter

- Know which room you are in (Blue or Orange)
- U= up front during the children's message
When the children come forward for the message you go with them, sit among them and assist with crowd control
- D= at the door of the KOK room waiting for the kids to come after the children's message. Set out the nametags at this time so the kids can find them in front of their room. Help prepare for snack. Get out cups and napkins and prepare snack. When children come down, greet them at their room door. Help place them find their nametag and place the tag around their necks. Welcome them to Kids of the Kingdom and ask them if they are ready to worship.
- Sit among the children. Help the storyteller with collection and keeping the children engaged.
- Assist and escort children to the bathroom if needed.
- Pass the snack
- Assist with the activity cupboard and cleanup
- Dismissed when church is over and KOK team/cell leaders come down.

Role of a Snack Provider

**** noted by an S behind your name

- Bring snack to share with all children
- Before church go downstairs to prep
- Fill up pitchers of water – right hand cupboard in the blue room
- Get out 2 Trays – right hand cupboard
- Set out 2 trays of cups (12 on each tray filled)
- Set out napkins on tray and snack on trays
- Might put empty cups on trays for visitors
- Put one tray in the blue room – on top of cupboard
- Put on tray in the orange room – on table in side room
- When church service is complete – clean up trays and empty water pitchers and you can take the leftovers home
- Put all supplies away

Plan for 27 kids and then adults and visitors in the rooms for the story telling.

Ideas for snack – keep it simple – no fruit, vegetables or nuts as we have kids with allergies

Cookies, pretzels, chex mix or other mixes, muffins, crackers (graham, animal, cheese etc.)

Role of a Story Teller

- Be prepared for the story (see schedule)
- Arrange carpet squares around your position
- Greet the children as they enter the room
- Pray when all settled in
- Pass the church for offering
- Markdown all kids present
- Tell story
- Pray before snack
- Pass snack
- Open activity cupboard
- Put all supplies away when church is finishing
- Dismissed when KOK team/cell leaders arrive
