We are quickly approaching the end of the 2023-2024 church year with 2 months remaining in the fiscal year. Receipts are currently \$98,000 below budget with a portion of this anticipated with Educational Savings Accounts. We will have elevated expenses with upcoming quarterly ministry shares and missionary support.

Please prayerfully consider what financial support can be provided to close out the year.

- 1) March MTD receipts were \$3,808 below the actual expenses incurred.
- 2) March YTD receipts were \$97,696 behind the approved budget.
- 3) March YTD receipts were \$11,087 below the actual expenses incurred.
- 4) Due to shortfall of actual receipts to budget, the quarterly denominational ministry shares were not paid in March.
